

**Call for Papers for the Annual Meeting of the

Concordia University, Montreal, 29-30 May 2010**

CAANS/ACAEN's 2010 annual meeting will be held at Concordia University in Montreal on 29-30 May 2010, to coincide with the Congress of the Social Sciences and Humanities. Concordia has adopted the Congress theme "**Connected Understanding / Le savoir branché**". From Concordia's Congress guide: "Connected Understanding speaks to scholarly activity and the impact of the rise of digital technology on scholarly research and research-creation; the links that scholars make with their colleagues in other fields and with larger audiences beyond the academic world."

We invite proposals for 20-minute papers addressing the conference theme or any other topic related to Netherlandic studies, including but not limited to: language, literature, culture, history, art and art history, politics. Presentations will be 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions and discussion and may be delivered in English, French or Dutch.
